

Vision Geothermal IWG

- Geothermal heat supplies:
 - > 25% of Europe's demand for space heating and cooling.
 - > 25% in the agricultural sector (greenhouses).
 - > 5% in industrial sectors in the low to medium temperature range.
- 10% of the power production in SET Plan countries is from geothermal power.
- Underground thermal energy storage supplies > 10% of space heating.
- Co-production of minerals and critical raw materials (CRM) in > 10 European regions.
- Resilience: 40% of the supply chain "Made in Europe" by 2030.
